

Dr. KL GOH



KL Goh is Professor of Medicine at the University of Malaya, Kuala Lumpur. He is Head of Gastroenterology and Hepatology and Chief of the Combined GI Endoscopy Unit at the University of Malaya Medical Center. He has published widely in international journals with papers (220 papers and 300 abstracts and 7 book chapters) particularly in the areas of *Helicobacter pylori*, gastroesophageal reflux and GI cancers and with a focus on epidemiology of these diseases in the Asian Pacific region. He is editor emeritus of the Journal of Gastroenterology and Hepatology (JGH) and treasurer of the JGH Trust Foundation. He is an editorial member of several international journals including the Alimentary Pharmacology and Therapeutics, *Helicobacter*, Digestive Diseases, J Digestive Disease and Digestive Endoscopy. He has been invited as faculty to several international endoscopy workshops and also organizes a well-known annual therapeutic endoscopy workshop in his University in collaboration with the Malaysian Society of Gastroenterology and Hepatology. His endoscopy unit has international recognition and was awarded the OMED Center of Excellence in 2008. He continues to take many international and local trainees for advanced endoscopy training. He is presently President of the Asian Pacific Association of Gastroenterology and Vice-President of the World Gastroenterology Organization and a council member of the Asian Pacific Society for Digestive Endoscopy (APSDE). He was a council member of the World Digestive Endoscopy Organization (OMED) from 2002-2005. Currently was the founder chairman of the New

Frontiers Endoscopy Forum (NFEF) and was also President and Organizing Chairman of the Asian Pacific Digestive Week 2010.
