



## **Brief Curriculum Vitae of Professor Salimur Rahman**

Professor Salimur Rahman is a veteran Hepatologist of Bangladesh and at present working as professor of hepatology Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical University which is the only medical university of this country. He is one of the founders of the discipline in this country. He is a co-editor of 1) 'Liver: A Complete Book on Hepato-Pancreato-Biliary Diseases' and 2) 'Comprehensive Text Book of Hepatitis B' published by Elsevier and Jaypee respectively. Professor Rahman has over 100 publications in international and regional journals. He is Editor-in-Chief of Euroasian Journal of Hepato-Gastroenterology, the official publication of Euroasian Gastroenterological Association and Viral Hepatitis Foundation Bangladesh. He is the current President of Association for the Study of the Liver, Dhaka, Bangladesh – the national association of Hepatologists of the country and the Senior Vice-President of Association of Physicians of Bangladesh – the premier platform of specialist physicians of Bangladesh. He is also the founder Chairman of Viral Hepatitis Foundation Bangladesh. He served as member national committee for Hepatitis B virus in Bangladesh and presently serving as executive committee member of Asian Pacific Association for the study of the Liver (APASL). He is the current president of South Asian Association for the Study of Liver (SAASL). Professor Salimur Rahman is a leading interventionist of Bangladesh and has pioneered the transformation of Hepatology from a theoretical to an interventional super-specialty in this country. He is a senior faculty member of the Department of Hepatology, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical University. He is a Fellow of Bangladesh College of Physicians and Surgeons, Royal College of Physicians of Edinburgh and Royal College of Physicians of Dublin.
