



### **BRIEF RESUME OF DR. S.K. SARIN**

Prof. S.K. Sarin, (Gastroenterology) is a Senior Professor of Hepatology and Director, Institute of Liver and Biliary Sciences (ILBS), the first dedicated Liver Institute, a deemed-to-be University.

Dr. Sarin has contributed internationally to develop Hepatology Discipline by developing new treatment protocols in Liver diseases and has published over 340 articles and 9 books. His research interests include Portal hypertension, Chronic hepatitis B, C and liver Cancer and has published in NEJM, The Lancet, Annals of Internal Medicine and Gastroenterology. He was also awarded the **Padma Bhushan** in 2007 for his overall seminal contributions to the Medical field in India. He is a **Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar Awardee**, TWAS International Prize Winner and a member of all three Science Academies in India.

He received the 'Best Teacher' award by API and has set up the first Asian Pacific School of Hepatology, in India. He is the founding Chief Editor of a prestigious Journal, Hepatology International (Springer International). Has served as the President of Indian Society of Gastroenterology, Asian Pacific Association for Study of Liver (APASL).
