



Dr. Bong Jan Jin graduated from the University of Leeds, UK, in 1996, and later in 2004, was awarded the degree of Doctorate of Medicine (MD) for the postgraduate research thesis. He received Higher Surgical Training under the prestigious Northwest Thames (London Deanery) Program. After completing his specialist training in general and hepato-biliary surgery, he continued the fellowship training at the Hammersmith Hospital, London.

After twenty years at the United Kingdom, Dr. Bong returned to his home country, Malaysia, in 2009. Dr. Bong was appointed Associate Professor (Academic) at the Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia. He has published over 20 papers in peer-reviewed journal, many of which were of original research in high-impact journals. Dr. Bong specialized in complex hepato-biliary and pancreatic surgery, and established the first laparoscopic hepatectomy program at Hospital

UKM. In 2012, he joined the Sunway Medical Centre to become a consultant general and hepato-biliary-pancreatic surgeon.
