



Dr. Zhuang Liu is a professor at Soochow University in China. He received his BS degree from Peking University (China) in 2004 and PhD degree from Stanford University (USA) in 2008. In 2009, Dr. Liu joined Institute Functional Nano & Soft Materials (FUNSOM) at Soochow University. Dr. Liu's research in the past few years was mostly focused on the development of functional nanomaterials for applications in biomedical imaging, drug delivery, phototherapy of cancer, and cell therapy studies. Dr. Liu has authored over 120 peer-reviewed papers, which have received a total citation of over 12,000 times (H-index = 50). He is now serving as the editorial board member for a number of journals including Scientific Reports (NPG) and Nano Research. The awards he received include MRS Silver

Award in 2008, SCOPUS Young Researcher Award in 2012, and Young Chemist Award of Chinese Chemical Society in 2014.
