

Professor Masaru Miyazaki



Professor Masaru Miyazaki graduated from School of Medicine, Chiba University, Japan, in 1975. He trained in General Surgery at the First Department of Surgery, Chiba University as surgical resident and fellow from 1975 to 1981. He moved to Toronto University, Department of Surgery as the research fellow in 1981, and stayed 2 years under Professor Ludy Falk. Professor Masaru Miyazaki obtained the position of Assistant Professor in Chiba University, Department of General Surgery in 1983, and furthermore he got the position of Associate Professor in 1993 at the Chiba University. Professor Masaru Miyazaki was promoted to the Professor and Chairman of Department of General Surgery in Chiba University in 2001. He was also promoted to the Director of Chiba University Hospital in 2011, and also to the Vice-President of Chiba University in 2011. Professor Masaru Miyazaki hold the 112th Annual meeting of Japan Surgical Society as the Congress President in 2012, and also hold the 49th Annual meeting of Japan Biliary Society as the congress president in 2013. He was elected as the President of the Society of Japan Hepatobiliary-Pancreatic Surgery in 2012. Previously he was invited as the Visiting Professor at Louisville University, USA in 1996, Yonsei University, Korea in 2003, Sanjay Gandhi Post-Graduate Institute(SGPGIMS),India, in 2005, and Cincinnati University, USA in 2010. He was also elected as the Honorary Membership of the Egyptian Society of Surgeons in 2010, and the Honorary membership of the European Surgical Association in 2014. He is still working as the Professor and Chairman of Department of General Surgery.
