I did my general surgical residency in the above mentioned institution which is recognized as one of the leading medical and post-graduate training schools in central India. I had the opportunity to do a wide variety of general surgical work initially under supervision and later (2002 –2005), independently.

POST MASTERS SURGICAL EXPERIENCE

1. **At present** I'm working as Consultant (Advanced Laparoscopy, Hepatobiliary pancreatic surgery and liver transplant Surgeon) performing advance laparoscopic surgery(laparoscopic colorectal procedure, laparoscopic upper GI surgery and laparoscopic HPB surgery), complex hepatobiliary pancreatic (HPB) surgery, Liver resection (Right hepatectomy, Left hepatectomy, Central hepatectomy Sectionectomy and donor hepatectomy) and liver transplant (Donor hepatectomy, recipient hepatectomy, back benching and implantation).
2. I was fortunate to work with dr. Subhash Gupta , eminent liver transplant surgeon in India. In Indraprastha Apollo New Delhi I had mastered the art of liver transplant and hepatobiliary and pancreatic surgery.
3. I worked with Dr.R.A. Sastry, Head of Dept. and Prof Dept. of Surgical Gastroenterology from Dec 2005 to Mar 2006, at Nizam's institute of medical sciences, Hyderabad. In this dept I was trained in major pancreatic surgery, liver resection, gastrointestinal malignancy and oesophageal surgery. Then I have joined DNB surgical gastroenterology on 25.06.2007 in Nizam's institute of medical sciences, Hyderabad for period of 3 years. I had the opportunity to do a wide variety of gastrointestinal surgery work initially under supervision and later (2007 – 2010), independently. I have completed 3 yrs training in surgical gastroenterology in June 2010. During this training period I had an opportunity to do a wide variety of gastrointestinal surgery work initially under supervision and later (2007 –2010), independently along with regular academic activity.
4. I was working with DR.K. RAVINDRANATH and DR. V. MATHAI from July 2005 to Nov. 2005 in the Department of Surgical Gastroenterology, Global Hospitals, Hyderabad. Global hospital is a well known referral centre for gastrointestinal surgery with three divisions, hepatobiliary pancreas and liver transplant unit, colorectal unit and advanced laparoscopic unit. During this period I was actively assisting in surgeries of the Pancreas (Puestows, Whipples, pancreatic necrosectomies), gall bladder, common

bile duct and colorectal surgeries. I was exposed to advanced laparoscopic surgeries (laparoscopic splenectomy, laparoscopic gastrojejunostomy, laparoscopic heller's myotomy and laparoscopic fundoplication).

5. I had worked as lecturer in Dr. V.M.Govt. Medical college, Solapur from April 2006 to Feb 2007 with Dr. J.T Sankpal. Dr. Sankpal is an innovative laparoscopic surgeon who had developed his own technique of two port laparoscopic appendicectomy and transabdominal pre-peritoneal mesh repair. I have performed several laparoscopic appendicectomies, laparoscopic duodenal perforation closure, laparoscopic hernia repair and diagnostic laparoscopies.

2. Journal club – weekly once. Original article or randomised control trials from Indexed journals are discussed to know how to do a study, how to write a paper, look for any pitfalls in study and are results good enough to change.
3. Gastrointestinal radiology meets – weekly once. Imaging and operative findings correlation is done.
4. Surgico - pathological meet – weekly once. Histopathologies of interesting cases are discussed.
5. Clinical case presentation – weekly once. Clinical case admitted in ward is discussed.
6. Problem case presentation – weekly once. Problem case in ward is discussed to analyse problems of diagnosis and management.
7. Audit - weekly once. Morbidity and mortality of admitted patients is discussed.
